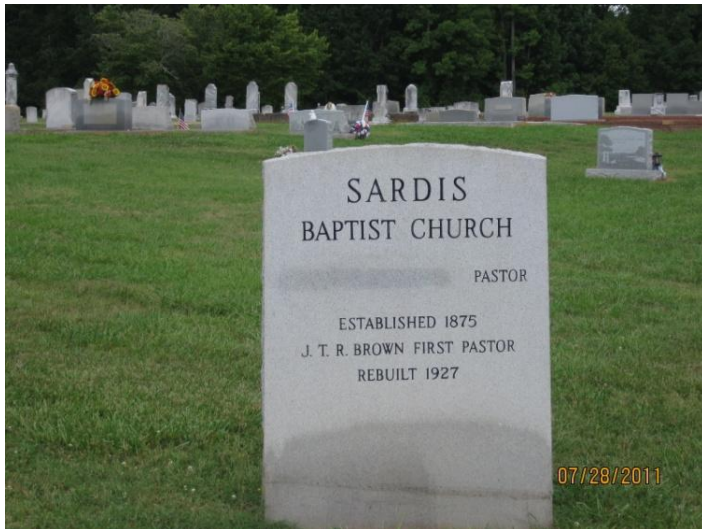

Sardis Baptist Church Cemetery is located on Sardis Road at the intersection with Hutcheson Ferry Road. It is across Sardis Road from the Sardis Baptist Church building, 8400 Sardis Church Road, Chattahoochee Hills, GA 30268.

The church was established in 1875 with the original church building on the southeast corner of the intersection (present parking lot) with the cemetery behind the church.

Burials recorded from 1935 – 1999 = 165 Marked Graves

Total = 277 Buried

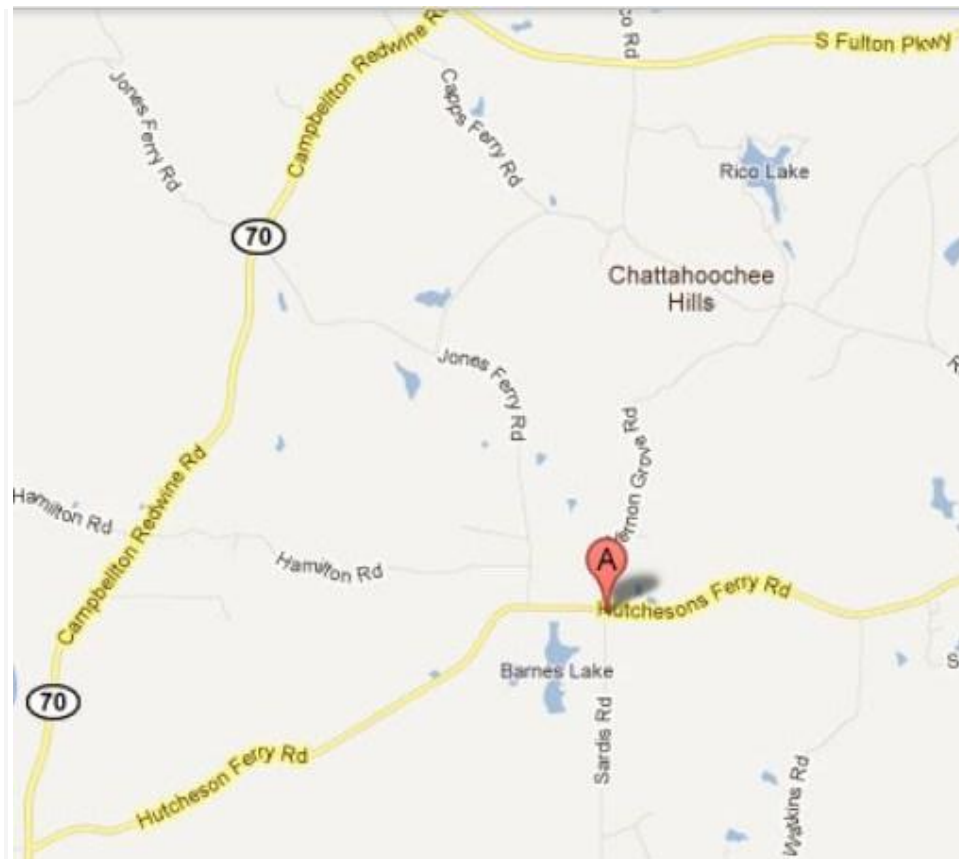

# Cemetery Rules and Regulations

Passed in Church Conference – Sunday, February 13, 2005

Committee: Alice Barge, Ray Hearn, Ned Peek, James Robinson

1. (a) A section of the church cemetery will be set aside for all non-church members and non-active church members who have not reserved lots. Approval for these lots must go through the cemetery committee.  
  
(b) This sections will be located adjacent to and south of the Waddell lots and initially consists of 12 lots.  
  
(c) Headstones only will be permitted. Walls and/or other structures will not be permitted in any areas of the cemetery.
2. A suggested donation of \$500.00 per lot from all non-members and non-active members who wish to be buried in the cemetery is required. This money will be placed in the cemetery fund for use in cemetery maintenance only.

Two members of the cemetery committee must be contacted for approval and proper location before any grave site is opened.

3. Any person other than church members who want a cemetery lot because of previous membership, relatives buried here, etc. must complete a “Request for Grave Lot” application and present it to a committee member.
4. A sign will be erected on the west side of the cemetery containing cemetery policy.
